Virginians have the right to know whether or not streams are safe for swimming, fishing, playing, and drinking. **Virginia Save Our Streams** mobilizes volunteers to monitor the water quality of local streams and educate the public about importance of clean water. Volunteers collect and identify underwater critters called macroinvertebrates. By identifying which macroinvertebrates live in local streams, volunteers can calculate a stream health score which can be shared with local and state agencies.
